

## **Mid-Year Check-In and Review**

To prepare for your mid-year conference and review, here are some tips:

- Review your Fall goals so that you are familiar with your growth targets.
- Be sure to have some data to see how your students are doing moving toward your growth goal. This could be a formal interim assessment, a few pieces of work as exemplars of your students' growth, or a smaller proof.
- Record your data for tracking purposes if you saved your baseline data in a simple to use manner. That way, you can see if your students are "getting there," and which students may need more supports.
- Reflect on the strategies that you identified as instructional tools to get your students to meet your growth goal.
- Reflect on the professional learning that you have taken part in thus far and how it may have fulfilled some of your PL needs and/or what else you may need from your evaluator.
- Keep in mind that this is a collaborative process, so ask for support or idea generation help from your evaluator.
